Parliamentary scrutiny must be required of any proposal to amend Royal Mail's Universal Service Obligation (USO).

The USO states the frequency and Quality of Service for our post. Royal Mail is proposing to reduce Second Class deliveries to three days a week, this change could be made without government scrutiny. We think this is wrong.

We also call on the Government to insist on changes to the USO are dependent on Royal Mail meeting existing delivery targets for letters and cards.
