



# PETITION

## Prevent Government removing DVLA services from the Post Office from April 2024.

We, the undersigned, agree with the National Federation of SubPostmasters (NFSP) and call on Government to reverse its decision to remove DVLA services from the Post Office network from the 31st of March, 2024. If this is refused, this then begs the question, does the Government not want a Post Office network?

### Why is this important?

Six million people use the Post Office network for accessing DVLA services per year. Half use cash to pay, many due to the cost of living crisis. As banks exit the High Street and communities across the UK, there is a growing requirement for a national infrastructure that can provide vulnerable customers with essential face to face services. This infrastructure is already in place via the network of privately-owned small businesses that make up the Post Office.
